## III. Responsibilities Of A Godly Wife

- A. A Help Meet (Genesis 2:18-20)
  - 1. Help Meet "aid"
  - 2. Crafted in likeness, intellect none like that among the creation of animals
  - 3. Are you being a helper or an obstacle? How would your husband answer?
- B. To Submit To Her Husband (Eph. 5:22-24, Col. 3:18, 1 Pet. 3:1)
  - 1. Submit "To subject oneself, to obey" Thayer
  - 2. Wives are to submit to their husbands **"as unto the Lord"**, she is to be submissive in the same way she voluntarily submits to Christ
  - 3. Wife is to submit to her husband the same manner as the church is to Christ
  - 4. Consider the relationship of Christ and the church
    - a. Christ is God's gift
    - b. Church looks to Christ as the cornerstone holds it all together (Eph. 2:20-21)
    - c. Church dwells in presence of Christ (Eph. 3:17)
    - d. Church experiences all-encompassing love (Eph. 3:19)
    - e. Church receives his gift of grace (Eph. 4:7)
    - f. Receives from him all that is necessary for growth (Eph. 4:15,16)
    - g. Imitates Christ's love (Eph. 5:2)
    - h. Learns what is pleasing to him (Eph. 5:9)
    - i. Lives in fear of him (Eph. 5:21)
  - 5. Christ expects certain things, yet He gives what is beneficial
  - 6. Paul requires wives to submit, yet expects husbands to model their behavior after Christ where they would request things that are pleasing to Christ
  - 7. The husband is respectful of this relationship and exhibits love (Eph. 5:25-33)
  - 8. Submission does NOT mean wife is inferior, less important, uneducated, never has opinion, suggestion, preclude her from expressing her thoughts, desires and aspirations
- C. To Reverence Her Husband (Eph. 5:33)
  - 1. Reverence carries the meaning of respect
  - 2. Do I respect my husband?
  - 3. In way I dress, keep the house, entertain guest?
  - 4. Are you openly appreciative of your husband?
  - 5. Are you helping your husband obey God and accomplish the Lord's work?
  - 6. Are you more likely to make your husband feel like a king or do you demoralize him?
