 - 1. Atheism
 - 2. Evolution
 - 3. Nov 2007 Reuters Poll 43% Catholics, 30% Protestants believe in Darwin's Theory of Evolution (Gen. 1:1; Ps. 83:18; Jer. 10:6)
- B. One Religion Is As Good As Another (Jn. 14:5-6; 10:9; 11:25)
- C. One Church Is As Good As Another (Mt. 16:18; Acts 20:28; Col. 1:18)
- D. Preach a One Sided God
 - 1. All about love and compassion, never mention sin, worldliness, judgment and the wrath of God (1 Pet. 1:17; Col. 3:25; Acts 17:31; Rom. 1:18)
- E. Promote Confusion Concerning Salvation
 - 1. Sinners Prayer (Jn. 9:31)
 - a. OT principle (Ps. 66:18-19, Pro. 15:29)
 - b. God doesn't fellowship with those who are evil
 - c. God did hear Cornelius, who was a sinner (Acts 10)
 - d. God did not save Cornelius through his prayer, he still had to obey the gospel and be baptized
 - 2. Downplay Baptism (Mk. 16:16; 1 Pet. 3:21)
