- I. Introduction**
  - A. Three main points
    - 1. Promise
    - 2. Panorama

- II. Promise (i.e. assurance):**
  - A. 2 Peter 3:4 – Peter speaks of “the promise of his coming.”
  - B. Promises – (“In the mouth of two or three witnesses...” – Here are 3 witness in addition to Peter)
    - 1. Angels – Acts 1:9-11
    - 2. Paul – Heb. 9:28
    - 3. Jesus – Jn. 14:3
  
- III. Panorama:**
  - A. Def. “panorama” – a comprehensive picture of a chain of events or a specific subject.  
Cp. “mountains” panoramic view. Following is a kind of “Panorama” of the 2<sup>nd</sup> coming.
  - B. Thing that shall will be heard.
    - 1. 1 Thess. 4:16 – 3 Audible things.
      - a. a shout.”
      - b. voice of the archangel”
      - c. the trumpet of God.”
  - C. Things that will be seen.
    - 1. Want to affirm: We Will See Him! (Rev. 1:7)
    - 2. Come in the clouds
      - a. Again – Rev. 1:7; Acts 1:11 (left with clouds; he will come with clouds).
    - 3. Angels will accompany him.
      - a. 2 Thess. 1:7; Jude 14
  - D. Other Details:
    - 1. Resurrection of the Dead: Acts 24:15; Jn 5:28-29.
    - 2. The Living: 1 Thess. 4:16-17; 1 Cor. 15:52-53; Phil. 3:21
    - 3. The Fate of the Earth: 2 Pet. 3:10-12

  - A. Mt. 24:44; 25:10
